Weigh-In: 1) Weigh-In is MANADATORY for black belt sparring competitors ages 14-32.

Weigh-in will be held at on Saturday, December 12, 2015, from 11:00PM - 12:00PM

at the Holding Area.

2) During the weigh-In, Black Belt Divisions will be setup so all competitors will know Who they will be matched up against.

IF YOU MISS THIS YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE. (VERY IMPORTANT!!!)

Competition Rules:

The current WTF & USTA competition rules will govern this championship. However, for color belts under 11 years old, the rules may vary upon the discretion of the CTU tournament committee.

Competitor Awards: 1st, 2nd & 3rd place winners will be awarded a Medal.

Children's divisions will be structured to ensure all children participants will receive medals.

for the schools with the Most Points. (1st place = 3 PTS, 2nd place = 2 PTS, 3rd place = 1PTS.) (Please be sure that all Entry Forms from one school/club bear exactly the same name)

Mandatory Equipment

WTF approved Taekwondo Uniforms only (no black trim except on black belt uniforms). All sparring competitors must wear (WTF Approved): white, red or blue headgear (must match with chest protector), red and blue reversible chest protector, forearm guard, shin and instep guard, groin cup and mouthpiece. Each competitor must provide his or her own equipment. Necessary equipment will be sold at the tournament site.

Electronic-Protector and Scoring System

E-Protector and Scoring System will be used to experience Olympic and World class games for Black Belt 14~32 years of age. In this category competitors must bring their E-Foot Protector. Those of you who doesn't have can be purchase or rent in the tournament site.

RULES AND ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The Essay Winners will be Announced at the Dec. 12, 2015 California Taekwondo United State Open.
- 2. CONTEST PRIZE; \$ 500 Per Essay Category (Three Age Categories)
 - Each essay will compete in only one of three categories;
 - Category A: Entrant is under the age of 13; or
 - Category B: Entrant is age 13 through 18, inclusive; or
 - Category C: Entrant is over the age of 18.
 - Determination of the winning essay is at the sole discretion of California Taekwondo United ("*CTU*"). *CTU* may, at its sole discretion, determine that no entry in a category is a winning essay.
- **3. ELIGIBILITY** All essay participants must be

currently enrolled students of a member school of *CTU*; and registered athletic competitors (Poomsae and/or Sparring) in the December 12th 2015 *CTU* CALIFORNIA STATE OPEN TAEKWONDO CHAMPIONSHIP, Cal Poly Pomona..

4. ESSAY TOPIC AND REQUIRED CONTENT

Topic and Subject Matter

- The Title of the Essay Must be "My Taekwondo Story;" and
- The content of the Essay **must** include and discuss each of the following sub-topics:

your personal experiences in life related to your participation in Taekwondo;

how Taekwondo has benefitted you in your life. As a part of that discussion, you must include at least one specific example.

your goals for both Taekwondo and your life and how your Taekwondo experiences will help you to achieve those goals.

You **may** also discuss:

- a) friendships that you have developed through Taekwondo; and/or
- b) qualities that you respect in the people that you know who are associated with Taekwondo.
- Required Format

The essay must be 1 ½ pages in length, exclusive of any headers, footers or title; and For determining page length, a page is 8 ½" x 11", with 1 " margins, single-spaced lines and size 12 ARIAL font; and

Each essay page must include a heading containing the name of the student and the page number for each page. The heading is <u>not</u> counted in the essay page length; and

Essays must be submitted in Microsoft Word format

RULES OF COMPETITION AND DIVISION

POOMSE RULES:

Poomse competitors must perform only the authorized poomse designated for their specific rank. Scores will be based on: Proper order, Beauty, Grace, Rhythm, Power, Technique, and Attitude. Authorized poomses are those approved by the World Tae Kwon Do Federation: Basic Forms 1 & 2, Taegeuk 1-8, Palgue 1-8 and WTF Black Belt poomses: Koryo, Keumkang, Taebaek etc. The chart below designates required poomses for your rank. To maintain consistency in competition, please wear the belt color corresponding with our ranking chart.

- Consists of 3 Members (No Specific Mix of Gender)
- Must wear matching WTF Poomsae Uniform or white Taekwondo uniform (Color Belts must wear white V-neck) / (Black Belts must wear Black V-neck)
- ALL Team Members MUST also participate in the Individual Events.
- Scoring will be based on: Synchronization addition to Regular Poomse rules.

No Head Contact Rule All Ages (Color Belts) and Ages 11 & Under (BLack Belts) Divisions

Sparring competitors Ages 11 & under black belts and all ages color Belts may <u>not make head contact</u> at any time during the competition. A competitor, who executes a technique to the head area, will be subject to one of the following actions.

- Any technique, attempted to the head area but does not make contact, will be given a warning by the referee (Kyong-go).
- Any technique, which makes any contact with the head area will result in a one-point deductions by the referee (Gamjeom)
- If the competitor cannot continue because of contact with the head area, the attacker will be disqualified.
- Inability to continue competition because of fright, crying, or loss of will following a legal kick to the body, does not constitute
 grounds for disqualification of the attacker.

Light Head Contact Rule Ages 12-17 (Black Belts) and 33 & up (Black Belt) Divisions

- The competitor is encouraged to attempt kicks to the facial area; however absolute control must be exercised or the appropriate
 penalty shall be invoked.
- The competitor who executes a successful technique (light contact without causing injury) shall be awarded one point.
- The competitor who executes a kick to the face or neck, which results in a minor injury, shall receive a one-point deduction. A minor
 injury is defined as an abrasion or bleeding caused by excessive contact.
- The competitor who executes a kick to the face or neck, which results in the inability of the opponent to continue because of injury shall make this determination.
- Note: Inability to continue because of fright, crying, or loss of will, following a legal kick to the head, does not constitute grounds for disqualification of the attacker.
- Certain rules and/or regulations are subject to change at the discretion of the California Taekwondo United Referee Committee and the Tournament Organization.
- Black belt competitors, Age 18-32 will follow WTF senior competition rules.

ROUNDS: * Competitors will have two - 60 second rounds with a 15 second break. * Black Belt competitors 14-32 years of age will have two - 90 second rounds with a 20 second break. * Finals bouts for 14 - 32 year old Black Belts will consist of three rounds.

* In consideration of time constraints, we reserve the right to change the duration of the rounds as necessary.

IN CASE OF A TIE: In case of a tie score, the winner will be determined by a SUDDEN DEATH round.

EQUIPMENT: Competitors must bring headgear, chest protector, forearm pads, shin, and instep pads, groin cup (males), and mouthpiece. Uniforms must be white with the exception of black trim V-necks for Black Belts only.

Black Belt 14~32 years of age. In this category competitors must bring their E-Foot Protector. Those of you who doesn't have can be purchase or rent in the tournament site.

DIVISONS: Each rank and age category will be divided into appropriate weight divisions. This determination will be made prior to the competition. 13 year olds and younger will have a maximum of 4 competitors in each division. 14 year olds and older will have a maximum of 8 per group. 14-17 years old Black Belts Division and 18-32 years old Black Belt Division will be determined by their weigh-in. Every effort will be made to pair each competitor with a compatible opponent. The California State Open Tae Kwon Do Championship Tournament Committee reserves the right to further divide or combine (within reason) the divisions to give all competitors a fair chance to compete.

2015 CALIFORNIA STATE OPEN TAEKWONDO CHAMPIONSHIP

BASIC KYORUGI RULE

1. Permitted techniques

- 1.1 Fist technique: A straight punching technique using the knuckle part of a tightly clenched fist.
- 1.2 Foot technique: Delivering techniques using any part of the foot below the ankle bone.

2. Permitted areas

- 2.1 Trunk: Attack by fist and foot techniques on the areas covered by the trunk protector are permitted. However, such attacks shall not be made on the part of the spine.
- 2.2 Head: The area above the collar bone. Only foot techniques are permitted.

3. Scoring Areas

- 3.1 Trunk: The blue or red colored area of the trunk protector.
- 3.2 Head: The entire head above the bottom line of the head protector.

4. Criteria for valid point(s):

- 4.1 Point(s) shall be awarded when a permitted technique is delivered to the scoring areas of the trunk with a proper level of impact.
- 4.2 Point(s) shall be awarded when a permitted technique is delivered to the scoring areas of the head.
- 4.3 Accurately, Powerfully
- 4.4 In consideration of weight category, gender, and age groups.

5. The valid points are as follows.

- 5.1 One (1) point for a valid attack on trunk protector.
- 5.2 Three (3) points for a valid kick to the head.
- 5.3 Three (3) points for a valid turning kick to the trunk protector. Ex) Spin Back Kick, Tornado Kick, Spin Hook Kick.
- 5.4 Four (4) points for a valid turning kick to the head. Cf) JSR: Three (3) Points for all valid kicks. No Four(4) points in JSR.
- 5.5 One(1) point awarded for every two Kyung-gos or every one Gam-jeom given to the opponent contestant
- 6. Match score shall be the sum of points of the three rounds.
- 7. Invalidation of point(s): When a contestant records points while using prohibited act(s):
- 7.1 If the prohibited act was instrumental to the scoring of the point(s), the referee shall declare the penalty for the prohibited act and invalidate of the point(s).
- 7.2 However, if the prohibited act was not instrumental to earn the point, the referee may penalize the prohibited act but not invalidate the point(s).
- 8. Penalties shall be declared by the referee.
- 9. Penalties consist of "Kyong-go (warning penalty)" and "Gam-jeom (deduction penalty)".
- 10. Two "Kyong-go" shall be counted as an addition of one (1) point for the opposing contestant. However, the final odd numbered 'Kyong-go" shall not be counted in the grand total.
- 11. A "Gam-jeom" shall be counted as one (1) additional point for the opposing contestant.
- 12. Prohibited acts.
- 12.1 The following acts shall be classified as prohibited acts, and "Kyong-go" shall be declared.
 - A. Crossing the Boundary Line. (Two Feet, any reason except by pushing)
 - B. Avoiding or delaying the match. Ex) "Kyong-go" shall also be given to the athlete who asks the referee to stop the contest in order to adjust the position/fit of protective equipment.
 - C. Falling down. Any reason except by violation of opponent. * If a contestant falls as a result of incidental collision with the opponent, no penalty shall be given.
 - D. Grabbing, holding or pushing the opponent

- E. Attacking below the waist
- F. Lifting the knee to block or/and impede the opponent's kicking attack, or lifting a leg to impede opponent's attacking movements without execution of any kicking movements.
- G. Butting or attacking with the knee

H. Hitting the opponent's head with the hand

- I. Misconduct of contestant or coach
- The following acts shall be classified as prohibited acts, and "Gam-jeom" shall be declared.
 - A. Attacking the opponent after "Kal-yeo".

- B. Attacking the fallen opponent.
- C. Intentionally attacking the opponent's head with the hand.
 - a) Intentionally striking the opponent's head with the hand.
 - b) Strong contact with the opponent's head using hand due to lack of caution
- D. Intentionally attacking below the waist. E. Misconduct on the part of a contestant or a coach.
- 13. If a contestant intentionally and repeatedly refuses to comply with the Competition Rules or the referee's orders, the referee may end the match and declare the opposing contestant the winner.
- 14. When a contestant receives ten (10) "Kyong-go" or five (5) "Gam-jeom", or in the event of any combination of Kyonggo and Gam-jeom that add up to five penalty points, the referee shall declare the contestant loser by penalties.

 15. In the event the winner cannot be decided after 2 rounds, a 3rd round will be conducted.
- 15.1 In case of a contest advances to a 3rd round, all scores awarded during the first two (2) rounds shall be void.
- 15.2 The first contestant to score a point or whose opponent receives two kyong-gos or one gam-jeom in the extra round shall be declared the winner.

 15.3 In the event that neither contestant has scored a point after the completion of the 3rd round, the winner shall be decided by superiority based the following criteria: Decision of superiority by judges shall be based on technical dominance of an opponent through aggressive match management, the greater number of techniques executed, the use of the more advanced techniques both in difficulty and complexity, and display of the better competition manner.
- 15.4 If the superiority decision is tied among the referee and judges, the referee shall decide the winner.

- 16.1 Win by Referee Stops Contest (RSC) / KO
- 16.2 Win by final score (PTF)
- 16.3 Win by point gap (PTG) In case of 12 points difference between two athletes at the time of the completion of 1st round and/or at any time during the 2nd round, the referee shall stop the contest and shall declare the winner by point gap.
- 16.4 Win by Golden Point (GDP)

16.5 Win by Superiority (SUP)

16.6 Win by withdrawal (WDR)

- 16.7 Win by disqualification (DSQ)
- 16.8 Win by referee's punitive declaration (PUN)
